The Raleigh-Durham Airport Authority will be conducting a Business Opportunity Workshop on May 8, 2019, beginning at 8:30 a.m. (registration begins at 8:00 a.m.), at the Sheraton Imperial Hotel Raleigh-Durham International Airport at Research Triangle Park, 4700 Emperor Blvd., Durham, NC. The purpose of this workshop will be to educate and inform the consultant and contracting community (i.e., Architects, Engineers, Planners, Environmental Specialists, General and Sub-Contractors) about upcoming capital improvement projects at the Raleigh-Durham International Airport. The agenda will include a briefing by airport staff, an overview of the typical consultant and contractor selection process, networking opportunities with other firms, and one-on-one meetings with select Authority staff (see “Speed Networking” below).
