List A OR List B AND List C

Documents that Establish Both Identity and Employment Eligibility

- U.S. Passport or U.S. Passport Card
- Permanent Resident Card or Alien
 Registration Receipt Card (Form I-551)
- Foreign passport that contains a temporary I-551 stamp or temporary I-551 printed notation on a machine-readable immigrant visa (MRIV) [Note that this document is subject to verification]
- Employment Authorization Document (Card) that contains a photograph (Form I-766)
- Foreign passport with Form I-94 or Form I-94A, Arrival/Departure Report bearing the same name as the passport and containing an endorsement of the alien's nonimmigrant status that authorizes such alien to work for a specific employer incident to this status. This document may only be used if the period of endorsement has not yet expired and the proposed employment does not conflict with any restrictions or limitations listed on Form I-94 or I-94A,
- Passport from the Federated States of Micronesia (FSM) or the Republic of the Marshall Islands (RMI) with Form I-94 or Form I-94A showing nonimmigrant admission under the Compact of Free Association Between the United States and the FSM or RMI.
- A foreign passport with special documents issued by the <u>Commonwealth of Northern</u> <u>Mariana Islands (CNMI)</u>. (Please see the US CIS <u>Handbook for Employers</u>.)

Documents that Establish Identity UNEXPIRED DOCUMENTS

- Driver's license or ID card issued by a State or outlying possession of the United States provided it contains a photograph or information such as name, date of birth, gender, height, eye color, and address
- ID card issued by Federal, State, or local government agency or entity provided it contains a photograph or information such as name, date of birth, gender, height, eye color, and address
- School ID card with a photograph.
- Voter's registration card
- U.S. Military card or draft record
- Military dependent's ID card
- U.S. Coast Guard Merchant Mariner Card
- Native American tribal document
- Driver's license issued by a Canadian aovernment authority

For persons under the age of 18 who are unable to present a document listed above

- · School record or report card
- Clinic, doctor, or hospital record
- Day-care or nursery school record

Documents that Establish Employment Eligibility

 U.S. Social Security account number card by the Social Security Administration that is unrestricted.

A card that includes any of the following restrictive wording is not an acceptable List C document:

NOT VALID FOR EMPLOYMENT

VALID FOR WORK ONLY WITH INS AUTHORIZATION

VALID FOR WORK ONLY WITH DHS AUTHORIZATION

- Certification of Birth Abroad Issued by the Department of State (Form FS-545 or Form DS-1350)
- Original or certified copy of a birth certificate issued by a State, county, municipal authority, or outlying possession of the United States bearing an official seal
- Native American tribal document
- U.S. Citizen ID Card (USCIS Form I-197)
- ID Card for use of Resident Citizen in the United States (USCIS Form I-179)
- Unexpired employment authorization document issued by USCIS (other than those listed under List A)
