Ways to Join The Shops of RDU

- Two ways to serve customers at RDU!
 - △ Sell Goods and Services to Airport Food, Service and Retail Operators
 - ∆ Lease Food, Retail and/or Passenger Services space to operate a store or

restaurant







Supply Goods and Services

- 20 food, retail, passenger services and commissary operators purchase goods
 - ∆ Basic office supplies
 - A Products and merchandise







Lease & Operate Food/Retail Space

- Quick service, casual dining, snack
- Convenience, specialty, personal care retail
- Passenger services
- Automated specialty retail
- Snack and beverage vending
- Advertising



Challenges for the Airport

- Single product line stores
 - △ Stores versus Kiosks/RMUs
- Untested concepts / Untested operators
- Narrowly focused merchandise lines
- Food prepared/supplied from off-airport
- Specialty snack/beverage vending
 - △ Single units, Units on the concourse



Airports: A Different Environment

- Length of Term
- Cost of Construction
- Airport Operating Environment
 - △ Impacts Employee Costs
- Inventory Managements
- Franchising Opportunities



Typical Lease Terms

- Length of Agreements
 - △ Terms range from 5 10 Years
 - △ Refurbishment requirements

- Hours of Operation
 - △ Minimum 12-hour day, 365 days/year



Typical Rents

- Concession Rent Higher of:
 - △ Percentage of Gross Revenue, or
 - △ Minimum Annual Guarantee Rent
- Percentage Rent Range
 - △ Food: 9% 15% of Gross Sales
 - △ Retail: 10% 18% of Gross Sales
- Minimum Annual Guarantee Rent



Cost of Construction

- Tenant bears design/construction costs
- Minimum Build-out Costs
 - △ Food: \$400/sf
 - △ Retail: \$350/sf
- Avg. Cost of Construction T1 2014
 - △ Food: \$478/sf, 5 units totaling 8,642 SF
 - △ Retail: \$441/sf, 4 units totaling 3,249 SF



Airport Operating Environment

- Security
 - Δ I0-year criminal history background
 - \triangle Badging lead time varies (days to weeks)
 - △ Some convictions disqualify for a badge
- Remote Employee Parking
 - △ Parking fees paid by employers
- Street-Pricing Program
 - △ Limits on product pricing



Concession Marketing Program

- Concession tenants pay a percentage into a joint marketing fund
- Funds are used for
 - △ Mystery Shop program
 - △ Promotional materials
 - △ Advertising
 - △ Customer Loyalty Program



Commissary Inventory System

- Retail/Food inventory received and delivered by a commissary operator
 - △ Individual store deliveries are made by the commissary operators
 - △ Commissary costs are based on:
 - △ Amount of space used in commissary
 - △ Frequency of deliveries
 - △ Volume of deliveries



Franchising Opportunities

- Territory Assignments
 - △ Airport included in territories, or
 - △ Airport carved out of territories
- Leasing Opportunity & Communications
 - △ Coordination through franchisor or territory holder
 - △ Based on brand's leasing model



Current Opportunities

- Terminal I
 - △ Food & Retail Leased through 2025
- Terminal 2
 - △ Food Expire 2019
 - △ Retail Expire 2015& 2017

How Do I Join The Shops of RDU?

- Methods Used to Identify Tenants
 - △ Request For Proposals
 - △ Community, Staff, or Self-Referrals
- Lease Types:
 - △ Prime Concession Leases
 - △ Direct Leases



Request for Proposals

- Issue an RFP
- Proposals are reviewed and rated
- Selected proposals are recommended
- Leases are approval by the Airport Authority Board



Experience Requirements

- 3 years experience in the last 5 years
 - △ Continuous ownership & management of food & beverage or retail concessions
 - △ Similar in scope and complexity
 - △ Shopping center, airport, mall, transportation center, street locations or other prominent retail setting



Financial Requirements

- Demonstrate the financial capacity to meet the obligations of the concession opportunity
- Submit documents verifying financial readiness
 - △ Financial statements, annual reports, balance sheet & income statement, credit/landlord references, etc.



Small & Disadvantaged Business Opportunities

- Airport Concessions Disadvantaged
 Business Enterprise
 - △ a small business, owned, operate and controlled a minority or woman







Purpose of the ACDBE Program

- Create a level playing field on which
 ACDBEs can compete fairly
- Avoid discrimination in the award and administration of concessions opportunities
- Help remove barriers to the participation of ACDBEs in concessions opportunities
